Position: Assembly Finisher
Location: Tulsa, OK
Classification: Full-Time, Non-Exempt

Job Summary:

Perform blasting, painting, and cleaning operations on components and products as directed by Shop Supervisor in order to meet production schedule requirements.

Main Duties/Responsibilities:

- Review drawings and job requirements in order to pre-plan production.
- Select and estimate the quantity of materials required from drawings, standards, and specifications.
- Setup and operate blasting and painting equipment in accordance with drawings, standards, and specifications.
- Work with Quality to ensure all blasting and painting meets all specified job requirements.
- Ensure all personnel are safely located prior to commencement of blasting or painting operations.
- Ensure blasting and painting equipment is in good working condition prior to and after use.
- Report any malfunctions or abnormal condition of equipment to Shop Supervisor.
- Assist building of tube bundles prior to installation in shells.
- Perform hydrostatic testing according to drawings, standards, and specifications.
- Preparation of exchangers for shipment.
- Work in a safe and secure manner and comply with the safety rules and procedures.
- Keep protective gear in good working condition.
- Perform small repairs and preventative maintenance on blasting and painting equipment.
- Assist in placing and removing components and products to/from the blasting and painting areas.
- Operate forklifts, and other mobile equipment (except heavy cranes) for the moving of material, components, and equipment from location to location within the plant. Occasionally operate overhead cranes.
- Perform general laborer duties as required (i.e. grinding, loading and unloading of trucks).
- Keep working area clean and perform housekeeping duties around the plant as required (i.e. pickup tools, roll-up hoses and cables, sweep).

Qualifications:

Any combination of education and experience providing the required skill and knowledge is qualifying. Typical qualifications would be equivalent to:

- Capable of reading and understanding Engineering drawings and documents.
- Capable of performing math computations involving decimals and fractions.
- Capable of lifting 50 lbs. up to waist.
- Requires 18 months minimum of job-related work experience.
- Working knowledge of different types of shell and tube exchangers preferred.
- Valid driver's license and proof of insurability preferred.

Compensation:

The successful candidate will receive a competitive salary and an attractive benefits package which may include, but is not limited to: medical, dental, life insurance and flexible spending account.

Screening:

All candidates will be subject to drug and alcohol screening and a background check prior to employment.
